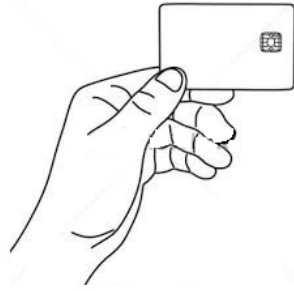
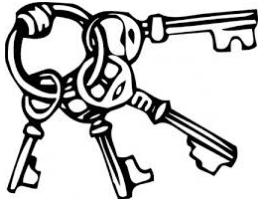
Pickle ball courts

Some keys were found at the recycling center since the last newsletter. If you think they might be yours please call the Village Hall at 262-285-7931 and give a description of them to us.



Have you been to the recycling center and found that your card doesn't work? You probably haven't renewed it for 2017. They expire on December 31st of every year.

The cost to renew your recycling card is \$20. If you need to purchase a recycling card because you don't have one yet the cost is \$25. Hours of operation (with access card )are 6am-10pm 7 days a week.

### Village Reminders

Dog owners are responsible for cleaning up feces left by their dog(s). This includes feces deposited on Village property (including the street), as well as private property. Failure to comply may result in a citation being issued for each violation

Dog owners are responsible for ensuring their pet does not habitually bark. After two written complaints are received, a citation may be issued for every violation thereafter.

No trailers or campers can be parked on any Village streets for more than 24 hours.

The yard waste area at Recycling Center is for Yard Waste Only! NO plastic bags, wood or plastic from pots may be left there. Please empty out your bags and take them with you. The garbage company won't pickup the yard waste dumpster if there are foreign objects in it.

Please dispose of cardboard in your own recycling carts at home. It fills the dumpster at the recycling center too quickly and that is something that can be disposed of in your own carts at home.

Do not place grass clippings on streets. In the interests of public safety, health and general welfare, community appearance and efficiency of operation, it shall be unlawful to rake or place grass clippings onto the pavement or into the gutter of any public street. No person shall permit grass clippings from mower swaths to remain upon sidewalks or on abutting property owned or occupied by him. You will receive a ticket for doing this.

Proper Disposal of Latex or Water Based Paint - DON'T POUR IT DOWN THE DRAIN!! If unusable, remove lid and place in a well-ventilated area. After contents have solidified, replace lid and place in the trash. Paint can be dried more quickly by pouring 1/2-inch layer into a cardboard box lined with plastic or newspaper or into a box filled with sand, vermiculite or kitty litter.
